that are poisonous to

In fact, yes! A number of seasonal plants are poisonous to pets if nibbled or eaten, including ivy, holly, mistletoe and poinsettias. It's best to keep these out of reach of your pets. Place them far back on counter tops, on high shelves, or even on the tops of your kitchen cupboards!

Q. My pet gets crazy when I have guests. What can I do to make them more calm?

Though the excitement of a party may overwhelm some pets, keep your pets inside during cold weather and provide plenty of toys to keep them busy. If needed, provide your cat or dog with a quiet room or crate during holiday parties and/or prepare ahead of time to discourage barking. And always remember to notify any guests coming over that you have pets!
