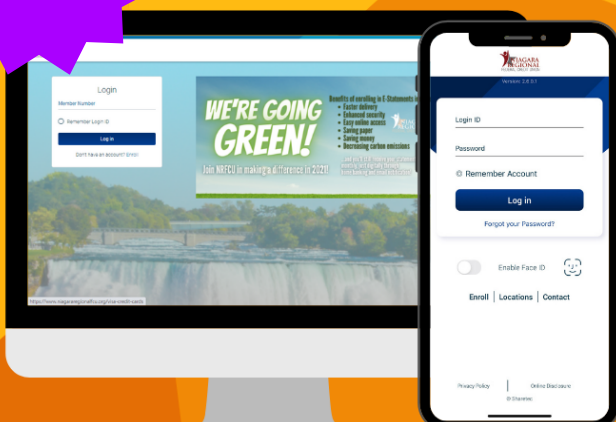

Q: Is the summer
pavement hurting
my dog's paws?

A: The rule of thumb is - if you can't put your hand on the pavement for more than 5 seconds, then that pavement is too hot for your dog to be walking on! And make sure to always check pavement temperature before starting a walk with your pet. Sometimes we forget when we have our shoes on and the pavement is much hotter than it seems! P.S. - This goes for sand, too!

Q: How can I keep my

A: Loud noises and flashing lights can cause distress in our furry friends. On holidays like the Fourth of July, this anxiety can be heightened. It's best to keep your pets away from this activity. Keep them indoors and close to you for comfort. If the noises are in close proximity to your home, try putting on soft music or the television to drown out any loud bursts. Another tip - make sure your pet is wearing an up-to-date name tag. Pets are more likely to run away from home on July 4th than any other holiday, certainly due to the surrounding commotion!
